
Hospice at Home West Cumbria Christmas Raffle 2025 Terms and Conditions

- 1. Each ticket for entry into the Christmas Raffle costs £1.

For paper raffle tickets, the completed counterfoil for each ticket purchased must be returned to Hospice at Home West Cumbria by the closing date (23:59 on Monday 8th December 2025) in order to be entered into the draw. 


