Home Nursing

Home nursing has always been at the heart of Hospice at Home West Cumbria. We offer skilled nursing care and support to adults with cancer and other life limiting illnesses. The care is provided in the patient's home or other residential setting. Many people wish to remain in their own home or close to their family and our home nurses allow them to do this.

Family & Bereavement Support

Hospice at Home West Cumbria provides a range of services to patients, carers and their families both before and after bereavement. Our team helps with coping, loss, grief and bereavement. Our highly qualified staff and volunteers support patients by providing complementary therapies, one-to-one sessions and group support.

Lymphoedema Services

We have a long established, specialist lymphoedema service which provides assessment, delivers appropriate treatments and supports and advises patients, their families and carers. We are the only provider of specialist lymphoedema services in West Cumbria.
