## About Us

### Home Nursing

Our home nursing team support adults with palliative and end of life care in their own home or other care setting, and also support families with respite care, where appropriate. The service is unique, with no other charities in West Cumbria providing home nursing.

### Lymphoedema

We are the sole provider of specialist lymphoedema services in West Cumbria. Lymphoedema is a chronic and often painful condition, and common causes include: cancer treatments, trauma and vascular disease.

### Emotional Health & Wellbeing

Our Family and Bereavement Support (FABS) team help patients and their families during some of their most difficult times. They offer a number of initiatives, including: Mindfulness; one-to-one emotional sessions and bereavement support.

### Complementary Therapies

Our therapists offer a range of treatments for patients and family members, helping to relieve stress and anxiety. Many of our patients who are close to end of life find the treatments give a sense of calm and peace.

## About 'Friends of Hospice'

As a registered charity, we need to raise over £1million every year to care for hundreds of local people who are going through some of the most difficult times. Regular gifts help us to plan for the future, giving us confidence that we have a steady income stream to support our essential services.
